

ROLE OF THE ASSOCIATE SUPERINTENDENT

Background

The Associate Superintendent, an executive officer of the Board, is employed to assist the Superintendent in the educational operations of the Division.

Procedures

More specifically the Associate Superintendent shall work to:

1. Improve classroom instruction and increase student achievement.
2. Enhance the quality of leadership in schools.
3. Improve communication between schools and other system stakeholders.
4. Ensure school and Division level accountability is maintained.
5. Fulfill other specific responsibilities as from time to time may be delegated by the Superintendent.
