

Administrative Procedure 547

Background

The cost of replacing and repairing public property, incurred through vandalism and theft, is of concern to the Division.

Procedures

1. Significant damage to property shall be reported to the Director of Facilities and significant loss of property shall be reported to the Secretary-Treasurer.
2. Damage and loss of property shall be reported by the Principal to the police when it appears that internal efforts to deal with the situation will not suffice.
3. The Principal shall make reasonable effort to have the Division compensated for damage or loss of property.
4. If the Principal is unsuccessful in obtaining compensation for damaged or lost property, a claim may be laid against the parents by the Division to recover the costs.
